Leisure & Culture Dundee – DISC starting PT offer; Caird Hall has meeting rooms for 14 – 60; McManus now have audio tours; L&C have produced a map and looking for feedback (Maureen handed it out and it's attached for comment)

Dundee Airport – actively involved in 2 Tay Cities projects; consultancy mid June (schedule will stay the same until end October) new tender package for next 2 years; helicopter flights starting this summer; private aircrafts p 40/45%

Unicorn – received funding from Heritage Lottery Fund; 200th anniversary soon and visitor numbers up eg Jan up 100%; lots of events planned

Apex Hotel – V&A package deal going well; looking at deal with FoxLake for corporate market
